Brief History

Cambridge University Press has been publishing dictionaries for learners of English since 1995. Cambridge Dictionaries Online has been offering these dictionaries completely free of charge since 1999.

Scope and Coverage

Cambridge dictionaries are informed by the Cambridge English Corpus, billions of words of real English, and the Cambridge Learner Corpus, a unique collection of exam scripts written by



students taking Cambridge ESOL exams all over the world. This dictionary has a large coverage of words from various links like Essential British English, Learner's Dictionary, English-French, English-Italian, English-Spanish, English-Portuguese, English-Catalan, Grammar, Essential American English, English-Arabic, English-Korean, French-English, English-Malaysian, Spanish-English, English-Turkish, English-Russian, English-Chinese (Traditional), English-Polish, German-English, English-Vietnamese, Indonesian-English, English-Thai, English-German, English-Japanese, English-Chinese (Simplified), English-Indonesian etc.

Kind of Information

This dictionary provides grammar, pronunciation (audio in UK and USA tone), etymology, examples, similar words etc. of the given word. The business meaning of the term is also provided. Facility to translate from English to other languages like Spanish, Italian, French, Arabic etc. is provided.

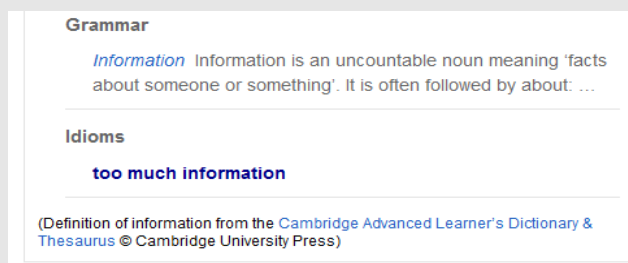
