The Government Directory is powered by African Directory Services and it is the African largest most effectively publisher of business and government institutions since 2000.

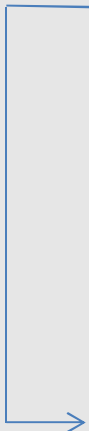
Scope and Coverage
