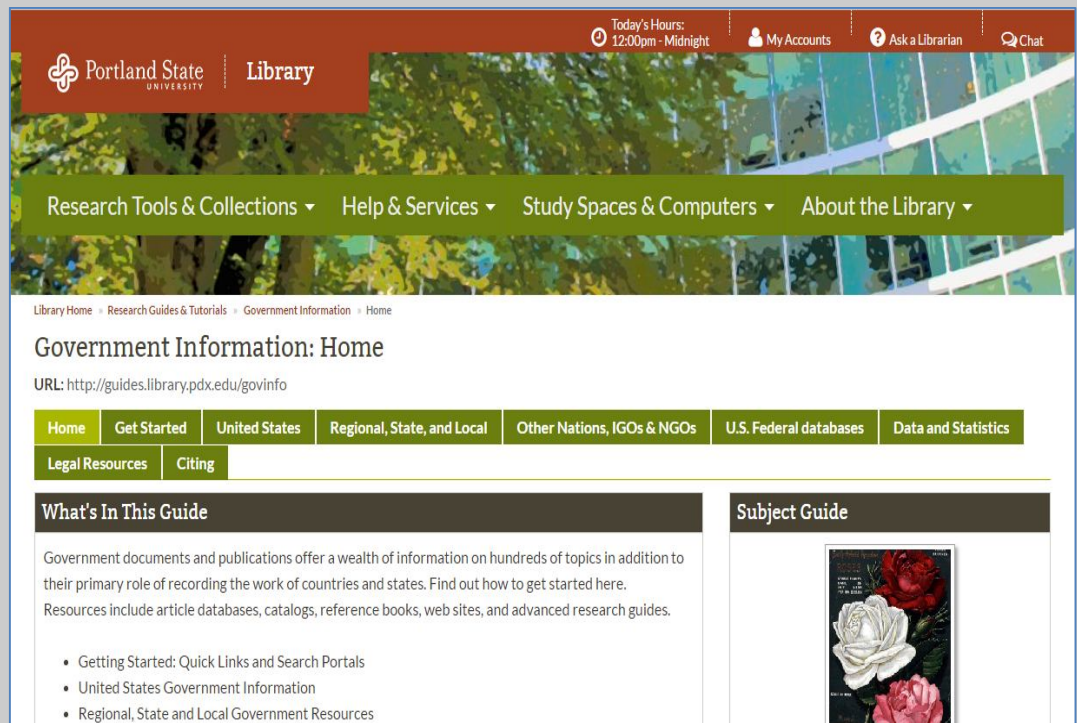

Kind of Information

Through this guide Federal information for all branches, including the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial arms of the United States government can be accessed. Users have to select the tabs at the top to navigate to information on different branch of the govt. Government Information on Regional, State, and Local; Government Information on other Nations, IGOs & NGOs; Government Information on U.S. Federal databases etc. can also be accessed from here. 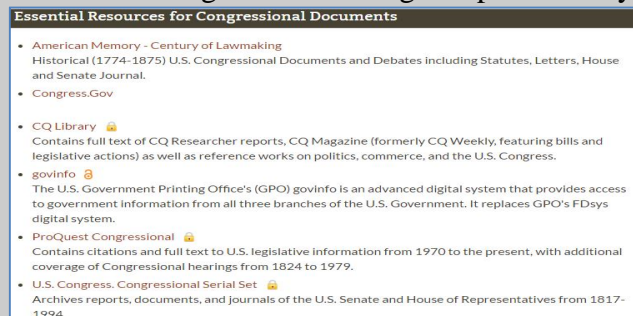
