StatsAmerica is a service of the Indiana Business Research Center (IBRC) and this IBRC has been monitoring socioeconomic trends and other such statistics since 1925.

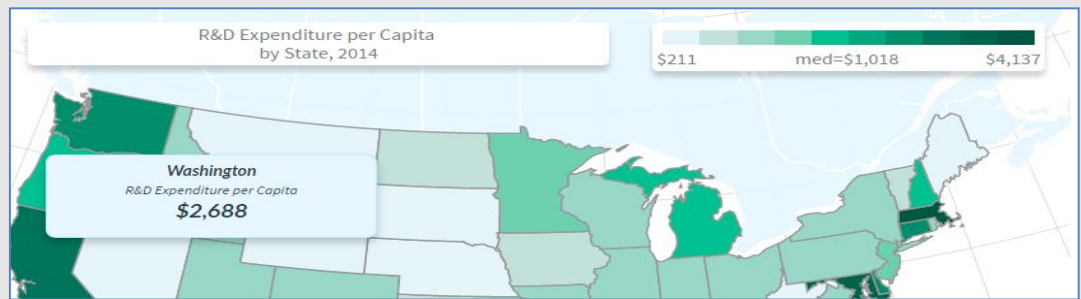
Scope and Coverage

It covers thousands of data items from hundreds of data sets from dozens of federal and state sources, along with some commercial or private source data. StatsAmerica adds value to these data through easy access and functionality of data can be known from the direct agency source of the data on every table, profile or map.

Kind of Information

It can be considered as one-stop destination for economic development data sites and tools. The U.S. cluster mapping site provides over 50 million open data records on industry clusters and regional business environments in the U.S. to promote economic growth and national competitiveness.

Data can be explored by regions, zip, indicators etc. Those can be seen through maps as shown below:



State wise data can be seen in tabular format. Such as, export related data of California shows following result:

It also provides information on a tool named ‘*measuring distress*’ which indicates a simple way to calculate whether a county, region or neighborhood may meet grant thresholds for unemployment and income. Innovation data browser can allow visitors to view and download individual data items for any state, metro, micro, district or county in the nation. An example is given below:

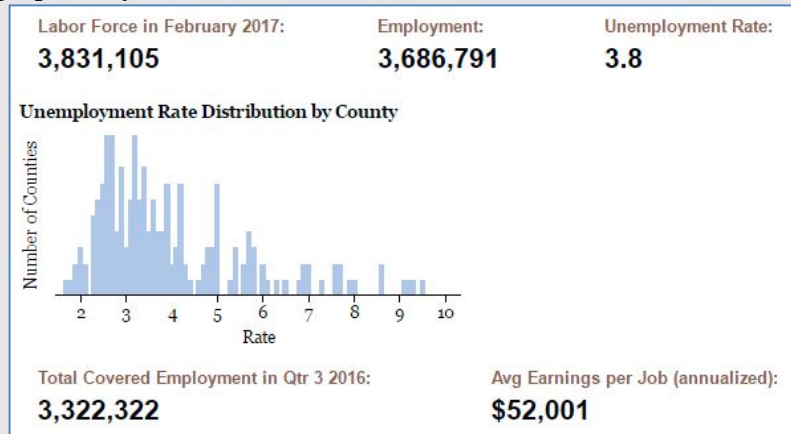
