

Brief History

The United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) is overseen by the United Nations Statistical Commission and was established in 1947 as the apex entity of the global statistical system and highest decision making body for coordinating international statistical activities.

Scope and Coverage

The Statistics Division prepares general statistical data compilations in print, including the Statistical Yearbook, Monthly Bulletin of Statistics, and statistical data compilations in special fields, including demographic and population statistics, international merchandise trade, national accounts, industrial commodities production, energy, social statistics and indicators, gender statistics and human settlements. The division also prepares a wide variety of technical studies on international statistical standards, recommendations and special studies approved by the Statistical Commission.

Kind of Information

The Classifications registry keeps updated information on Statistical Classifications maintained by the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD). The section on 'National Classifications' includes information on national practices in the area of classifications, covering activity and product classifications used in countries around the world. Rulings, corrections, interpretations and proposals for future revisions are recorded and can be viewed from the 'Registry entries'.

In UNSD publications catalogue, the publications are given including series, sales no., price, brief description, language etc. An example is shown below:

The 2014 <i>Energy Balances</i> contains energy balances for more than 200 countries and territories, showing production, trade, transformation and consumption (by sector) in energy units for all energy products.

This division generally gives emphasis on coordination, environment, development indicators, geospatial information and people & society.

UNSD programme includes different types of statistics like statistical classifications, big data for official statistics, development indicators, geospatial information, demographic and social statistics, gender statistics, industry statistics, trade statistics, tourism statistics, national accounts, energy statistics, environment statistics, environmental-economic accounting etc.

The Monthly Bulletin of Statistics Online presents current economic and social statistics for more than 200 countries and territories of the world. It contains 55 tables, comprising over 100 indicators, of monthly, quarterly and annual data on a variety of subjects illustrating important economic trends and developments etc.

The United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) is conducting an Expert Group Meeting on Management and Evaluation of Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Systems. The main objective is to review the draft of the revised Handbook on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Systems: Management, Operation and Maintenance; to provide further guidance on its content and structure with a view to ensuring that it provides countries with a reference document on the management aspects of civil registration and vital statistics, including evaluation of completeness. The revised Handbook is expected to be submitted to the United Nations Statistical Commission for adoption.


